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Dear Students and Pastors:

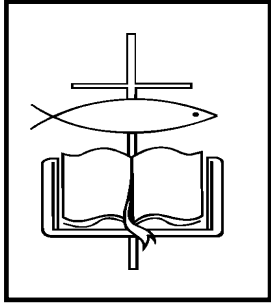
Some exciting things are taking place with our school of ministry beginning this fall. Here is a summary of what you can expect:

1. Every class will be available to take through a video conferencing option. This means that anyone, regardless of their location on the district, may take any of the classes. Our hope this will make the classes more available to all of our students resulting in fewer classes having to be cancelled due to low registration.
2. We will be offering four classes each session, all at four different times. To do this we have added a Saturday morning class offering. This will mean that people needing more than one class will be not have a scheduling conflict due to both classes being offered at the same time.
3. Every class in the course of study will be offered at least once during a two-year time period. In addition, we have designated some classes (Becoming a Holy People, Exploring Nazarene History and Polity, and Supervised Ministry Experience) every year.
4. One class, Tracing the Story of God, has been divided into an Old Testament and a New Testament class. By doing so we will make the material for this class more manageable, enhancing the learning experience for our students.

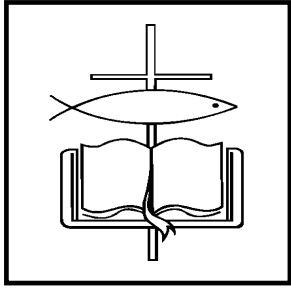
